Wishes involving travel may not be the direction your wish child wants to go in, and there are still so many possibilities to create meaningful local wish experiences for wish children and families. The information below is intended to spark ideas and creative thinking among wish granters and is not to be shared directly with families or considered a picklist from which kids should choose.

Animal Wishes



• Animal wishes can bring comfort and companionship to a wish child for years to come. We can work with local shelters or breeders to find the perfect pet!

**Timing is breed dependent. For puppies, the dog will need to be with the mother for between 8-12 weeks (about 3 months), then delivered to the child.

Make-A-Wish can provide:

- The requested animal within our budget that fulfills the essence of the child's wish
- \$1,000 reimbursement for standard routine vet services to include pre-adoption veterinarian check, immunizations, spay/neuter, and routine veterinarian checks for the first year
- Starter supplies to include food, food dish, collar, leash, litter box, etc.
- Delivery of the animal to the family's home or wish reveal at the vendor's location

Wish family is responsible for:

- Obtaining necessary permitting/licensure for owning the requested animal
- Obtaining and paying for insurance for the animal
- Ongoing maintenance and expenses related to the animal after the first year
- Ensuring the home is suitable for the animal
- Securing approval in writing from their landlord to own a pet (if renting)

Other things the family may want to consider:

• Make-A-Wish Illinois would replace the animal within three months of purchase only in the event of the animal's death by disease or congenital defect only.

• Once the family receives the animal they will be the sole owner and it cannot be returned to Make-A-Wish Illinois.

Adaptive & Medical Equipment

Sports Equipment



If your wish kid dreams of pursuing their dream in athletics, we have a variety of options that would support their goals! We can work with local vendors to purchase and deliver requested sports equipment.

Timing Expectations

• 4 - 5 months

For Wish Celebration Volunteers - wish boost ideas can include:

- Jersey/uniform from the wish child's favorite team
- Video compilation of great plays, catches, goals, etc.
- Invite local high school team to help with a wish celebration/throw the first pitch of a game

Musical Instruments/DJ Equipment



Musical instruments and/or equipment can provide a wish child with a creative escape. We can work with local vendors to plan and deliver wish items that fit the essence of their creativity!

- An outfit to go shopping in
- Trendy reusable bags to carry around necessities for the big day





Education Wishes



Whether it's online classes, payments to their school, or sessions to learn from an origami expert, we can celebrate a wish child's desire to learn and advance.

Additional Requirements Needed from FamilyAcceptance letter from the school (if applicable)

Timing Expectations

Philanthropic Wishes



Celebrate a wish child's generosity and community focus through a direct monetary contribution to a charitable organization, donating an accessible swing to a local park, or thanking their medical team. These are all examples in which a philanthropic wish would take place.

Timing Expectations

For Wish Celebration Volunteers - wish boost ideas can include:

- Shirt, hat, or other merch from non-profit benefitting from wish
- Letter of thanks from non-profit staff, volunteers or beneficiaries

Wishes to Be



Talk about the transformative power of a wish! We can work with local organizations and creative geniuses to help a child transform into a superhero, actress/actor or whomever else they wish to be for a day.

Timing Expectations

- Redecoration projects often take longer than expected.
- Home may be in a state of disarray during the project.





- The list the family sends is placed in priority order and Make-A-Wish will do their best to fulfill the list of items requested but will ultimately remain within the specified budget for this wish type.
- Projects involving structural changes, addition and/or relocation of electricity, ventilation, and cooling/heating systems, and/or plumbing will not be allowed.
- Make-A-Wish will review the type of work that needs to be done and if it is deemed to be construction the child will be asked to forgo that aspect of the room redo or select an alternative wish.

For Wish Celebration Volunteers - wish boost ideas can include:

- Sending items ahead of time for the child to make/decorate DIY wall art, paint small items to be incorporated into the room, corkboard display
- Set up signs and/or construction tape to indicate work in progress to maintain an element of surprise
- Friends/family fill a mason jar with encouraging thoughts for the child to read
- Host a ribbon cutting ceremony with big scissors

Make-A-Wish can provide:

- Car customization within our budget that fulfills the essence of the child's wish.
- Renovation, restoration and/or customization to the body and/or interior of the car.

Wish family is responsible for:

- Providing documentation that the car being refurbished is registered and licensed in the wish family's name and meets/passes all state required safety and emissions tests.
- Providing the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN).
- Bringing the car to an auto technician (to be determined by Make-A-Wish) to validate that the car is in reasonable condition (defined as meeting Kelley Blue Book standard for "Fair" vehicle quality or higher) to allow a refurbishment to take place.
- Non-cosmetic repairs required to bring the vehicle to "Fair" quality, if applicable
- Working with staff to make a prioritized list of specific cosmetic repairs
- On-going maintenance, additional improvements and expenses related to the use of the car customization





Other things the family may want to consider:

- We are unable to do any work on the motor or inner workings of the vehicle. We can only do cosmetic changes.
- There may be several weeks to months where the car will be unable to be used.
- It may not be possible to do all of the repairs and refurbishments requested, but every effort will be made to complete the customization in the priority established by the child.
- Once the customization work has begun, the specific vehicle cannot be changed nor can the wish be changed to something else.
- Until the wish has been granted, the customization arrangement is between the vendors and Make-A-Wish Illinois. Any questions or concerns will be handled through Make-A-Wish staff or volunteers. We ask that families not directly contact the company handling the car customization without first talking with Make-A-Wish.
- The vendors we use to provide the wish are under no obligation to provide any goods or services to your family after the wish and should not be asked to do so.
- Once your family receives the car customization, the improvements will be the family's property and cannot be returned to Make-A-Wish Illinois.

- Car cover, big sheet or giant bow for reveal
- Invite car club or other auto enthusiasts to be part of wish celebration
- Bucket of car care goodies

- Obtaining necessary permitting/licensure for the vehicle at the local Department of Motor Vehicles
- Obtaining a trailer and hitch as well as completing any modifications to your family's vehicle, if necessary, for towing the motorized vehicle (installing a tow hitch, etc.).
- Obtaining and paying for insurance for the motorized vehicle.
- Ensuring the wish child completes a safety course prior to delivery of the motorized vehicle.
- Ongoing maintenance and expenses related to the use of the motorized vehicle.
- Parking or storage arrangements and related fees for the motorized vehicle.
